

## CS TIMECLOCK SPECIAL KEYPAD COMMANDS

The CS TimeClock is preprogrammed with several special key number commands, which range from allowing you to add and employee to setting up the clock's network setting.

The special key's are listed below:

- 900 -- [Reserved for future Menu System]
- 901 -- Show Employee Details
- 902 -- Show Employee Number
- 920 -- Show Clock Information – Version, Serial, Time Zone, IP
- 921 -- Set IP
